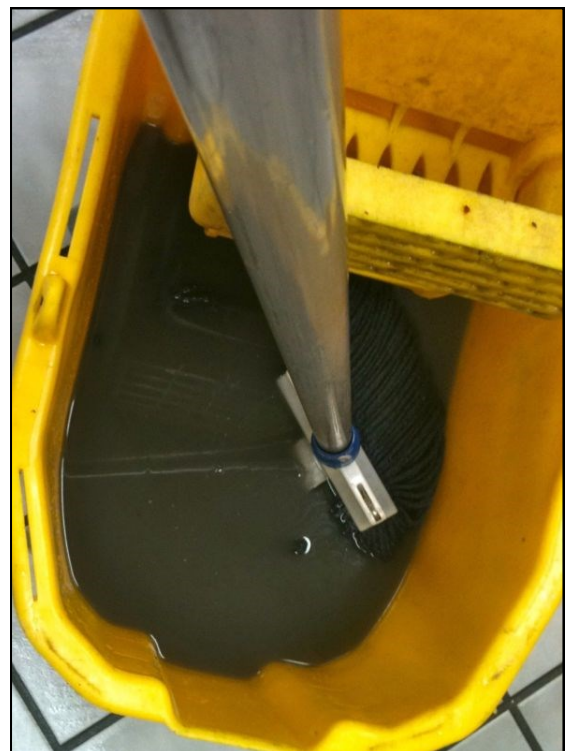
Used Mop Water is a Window into your Floor's Condition

Most people can agree that standard mopping simply moves dirt and grease across the floor, causing build up in grout lines, cracks, crevasses or even texture put on the tile for the soul purpose of making it safer. To make matters worse, cleaning products also build up over time, leaving behind a dangerous residue. This not only leads to a dirty floor but, what is more important, it reduces traction or slip resistance increasing the chance of a very costly slip and fall accidents. Over the past eighteen years we have learned things that just make sense and below are a few to give you the gist of our theories. Please view our videos and read our blog to see a different approach to floor care.

-Dirty mop water doesn't mean you are cleaning, it means the floor is filthy and needs to be effectively scrubbed. Black, dirty used mop water = a dirty floor. Relatively clean mop water = a clean floor and your procedures are working. By monitoring used mop water one can effectively manage any floor condition

-Grout is not black! The more a floor is mopped, the dirtier the tile and grout will become. When mopping a leveling effect occurs creating buildup whether using a string mop or a pad system.

-To offset the damage done by mopping you **MUST** effectively scrub the floor on a regular basis. Depending on what type of facility you operate, once a month is a minimum. Of course, the more you scrub the cleaner the floor will be, validated by the clean used mop water.

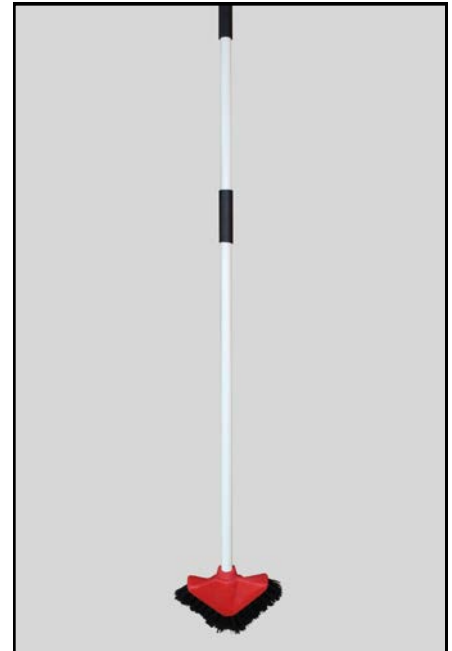

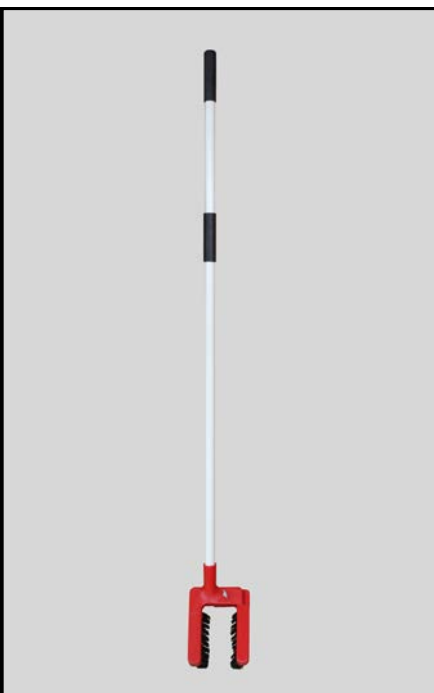

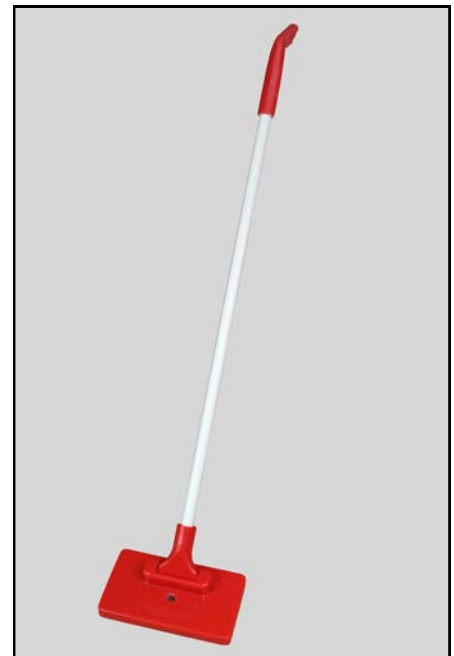

How To Use The Heavyweight®

Proper Use is Key

DO NOT PUSH DOWN



Standing with **BOTH** hands on the pistol grip, shoulders parallel to the pole, simply **PUSH** and **PULL** in a Sweeping Motion.



No more using your back.

The Heavyweight® **NEVER** has to be lifted.



The Heavyweight® is a sixteen pound weighted scrub brush. The sixteen pound head applies a constant force on the floor so you don't have to.



BOTH hands on pistol grip.



Hinged handle for cleaning under the equipment.

DO NOT store on wheels. When storing simply place on flat surface.



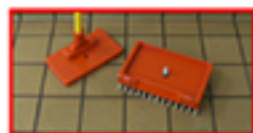
Simply kneel next to brush and push and pull.

Each pad is equipped with **WHEELS** for easy transportation.



To transport: simply pull the pole past the rest position on to its wheels and roll away.

To remove pad, simply loosen the nylon nut and lift weight assembly away from the pad.



BE CAREFUL of any pipes or wires under equipment.

Adjustable Leg Brush and Baseboard Brush

Baseboard Brush



Use the Baseboard Brush to remove residue left from mopping.

When using, stand with the pole between you and the wall and scrub.



Proper body position insures the bristles form properly with the baseboard and the floor.

Adjustable Leg Brush

The Adjustable Leg Brush is used to clean around kitchen equipment, legs, wheels, tables, restroom partitions or any other obstacle fixed to the floor.



To adjust brush size, loosen the wing nut and slide brush to desired position then tighten nut.

Heavyweight® Best Practices:

1. Using the Baseboard Brush, stand with the pole between you and the wall, scrub the baseboards.
2. Using the Adjustable Leg Brush, adjust to needed size and clean around all legs, partitions or any other objects fixed to the floor.
3. Wheel the The Heavyweight to the cleaning area. Standing with both hands on the pistol grip, shoulders parallel to the pole scrub the floor in a sweeping motion. **REMEMBER: DO NOT PUSH DOWN ON THE HEAVYWEIGHT.**
4. Remove scrubbed residue.
5. Rinse each brush thoroughly, then store properly.



Rinse all products off after every use.

Heavyweight Knockout Rules:

1. When using The Heavyweight **DO NOT** push down or use your back.
2. The Heavyweight **NEVER** should be lifted.
3. **BEWARE** of wires, pipes or hoses when using The Heavyweight under kitchen equipment.
4. **NEVER** store The Heavyweight on it's wheels.

The Heavyweight Scrub Brush comes with a 2 year warranty on the pole and weight assembly.



Do not stand on wheels, store with bristles flat on the floor
